RPSS Operational Guidelines for Customers

Advisory No. 3

To our valued Customers, in line with the *RPSS Operational Guidelines for Customers* dated on 26 May 2020, and *RPSS Operational Guidelines for Customers Advisory No. 2* dated 24 August 2020, please find below additional guidelines regarding the Personnel Monitoring Services (PMS) provided by the Radiation Protection Services Section.

Due to the difficulties brought by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and delay in procurement of new dosimeter supplies, the current inventory of personal dosimeters in the RPSS laboratories is limited. Hence, please be guided by the following:

1. New applications to the PMS for RENTAL of dosimeters will be temporarily suspended. During this period, submission of documentary requirements such as service requests and letter of agreement; and payment for the service will not be accepted.

The PMS will resume acceptance of new applications for RENTAL once all those currently in the waiting list have been served and there is sufficient supply of dosimeters. This guideline supersedes Item No.1 of the RPSS Operational Guidelines for Customers Advisory No. 2 (24 August 2020)

2. New applications to the PMS for CUSTOMER-OWNED dosimeters will be accepted. The customers have the option to procure their own Optically-stimulated Luminescence (OSL) dosimeters of the same technical specifications & use it for personnel monitoring. To avail of this option, customers must first submit the OSL dosimeters to RPSS before its use, together with the PMS Service Request.
3. For existing customers of the PMS, please be reminded to return ALL dosimeters to PNRI and settle all late penalties. Customers with outstanding balances and/or those who have not returned all issued dosimeters may not be allowed to renew their subscription.
